

Connect to the Internet Wirelessly- MAC OS

Installation Instructions**Requirements**

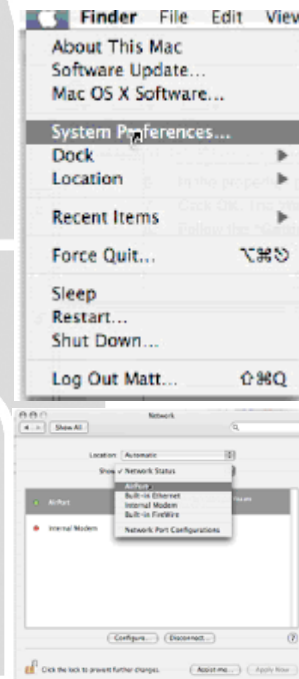
In order to connect your Macintosh to the Apogee wireless network, you need to ensure that your computer has an Airport Extreme wireless card installed. If you do not have an Airport Extreme and would like to know if one may be purchased for your specific model of computer, go to apple.com.

- Go to the top of the screen and click on the Airport icon in the Menu Bar.
- If Airport is on the icon will be blue
- If Airport is off, the icon will be gray
- Click the icon to turn Airport on.
- Select Apogee from the list of available wireless networks.
- Open up your web browser (usually Safari).
- Enter your username and password and press the Login button. You are now connected.

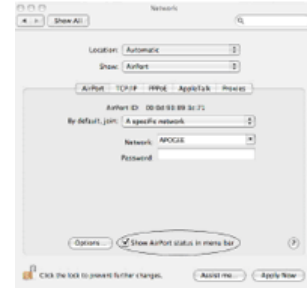


If you have an Airport Extreme, but the icon is not in the Menu Bar.

- Click on the (Apple) in the top left corner of the screen
- Select System Preferences.
- From the System Preferences Window, click on Network.
- From Network window, select Airport from the Show pull-down menu.



- From the Airport Preference Pane, check Show Airport Status in Menu Bar.
- Now and close System Preferences.
- Follow the Getting Connected directions from above.
