PowerPoint Games

- ☀ PowerPoint Games are a great opportunity to prepare students for upcoming tests, or review difficult concepts.
- ☀ The process allows you to create tests in a yes-no format
- ☀ There are a variety of pre-formatted games available online, or you can create your own
- ☀ The purpose of this lesson is to show you how the process works

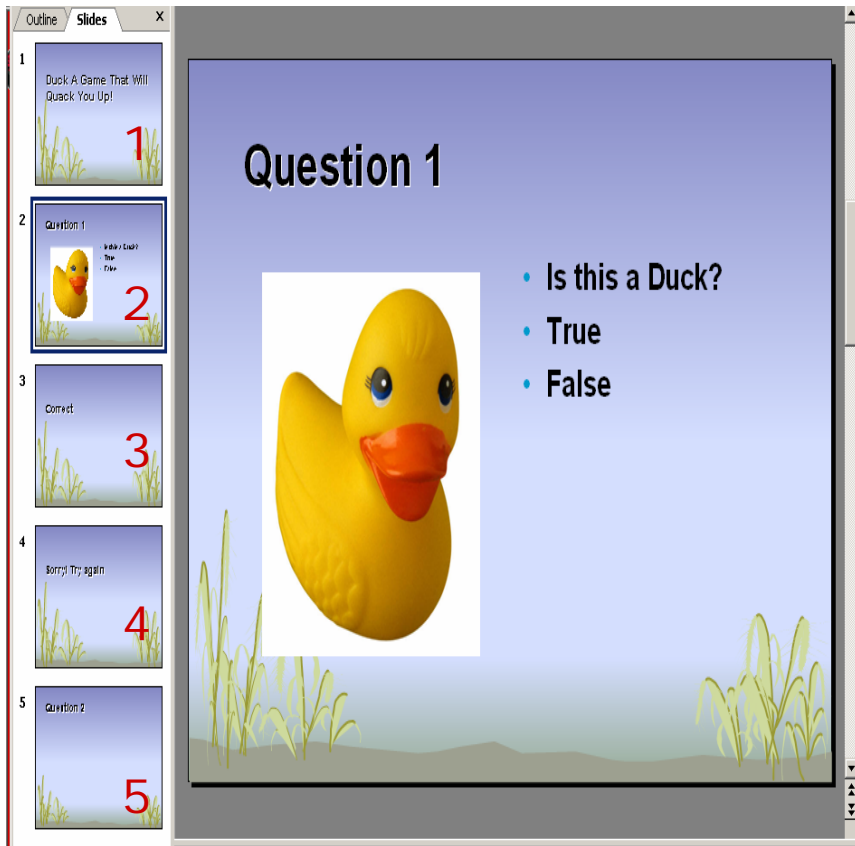


PowerPoint Games

- ☀ The idea behind linking slides shows for games takes a bit of explanation and some patience.
- ☀ The linking process requires a minimum of 4 slides for each Question
 - ☀ Slide 1-The Question
 - ☀ Slide 2-The Correct Answer
 - ☀ Slide 3-The Incorrect Answer
 - ☀ Slide 4-The Next Question



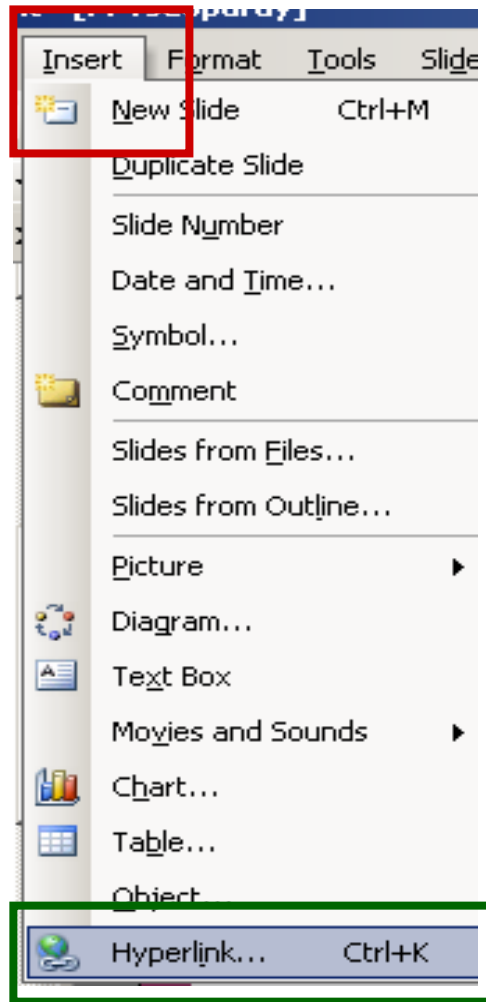
PowerPoint Games



- ☀ *Open* the pre-formatted show called “Duck”
- ☀ On the left side of the slide you will see **5** slides. Click on each one
- ☀ Slide **1** is the title slide
- ☀ Slide **2** is the question
- ☀ Slide **3** is the correct answer
- ☀ Slide **4** is the Incorrect answer
- ☀ Slide **5** is the next question



PowerPoint Games



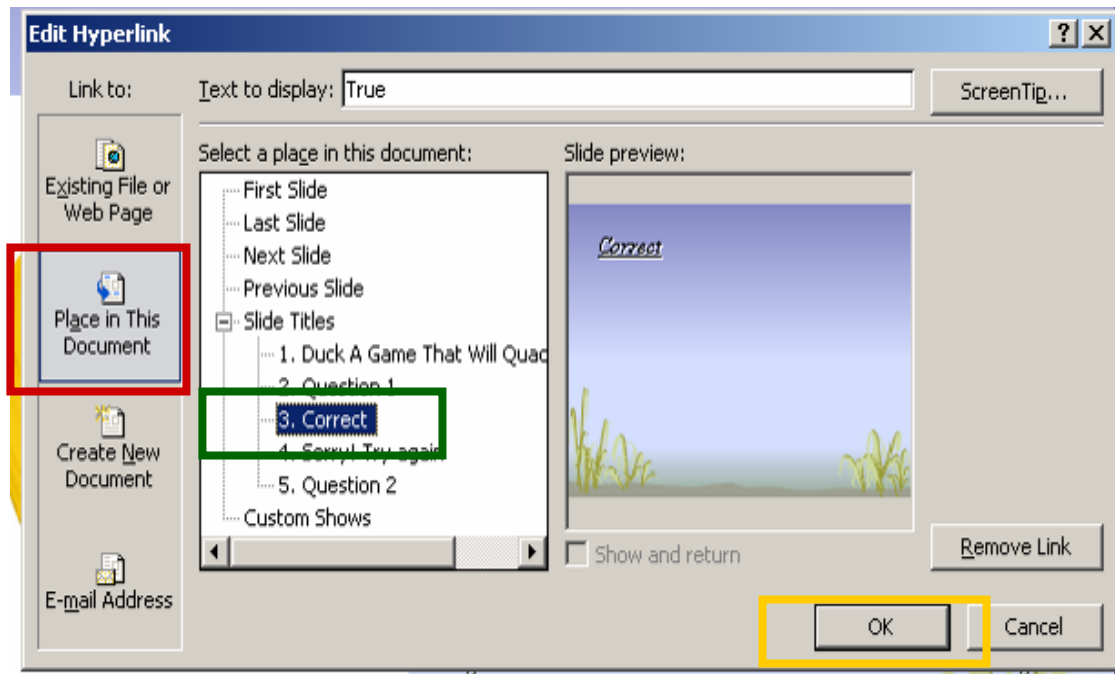
☀ Click on **Slide 3** and highlight the word *Highlight* the word **True**

☀ Click **Insert**

☀ Click **Hyperlink**



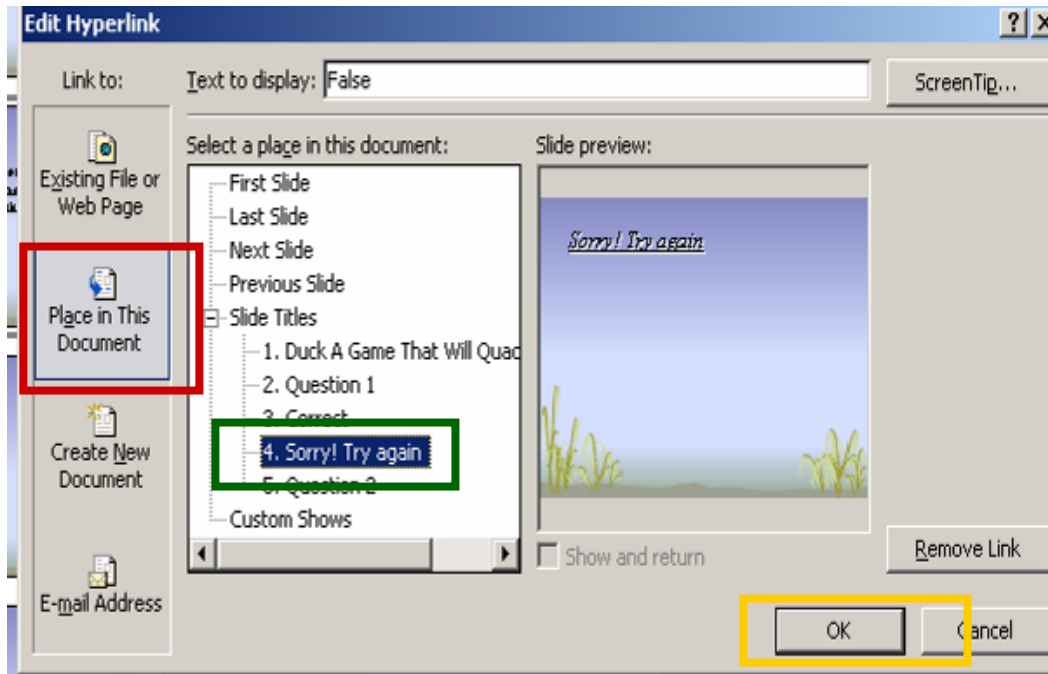
PowerPoint Games



- ☀ The **Edit Hyperlink** menu opens
- ☀ Choose **Place in this Document**
- ☀ Choose the slide **“Correct”**
- ☀ Click **OK**



PowerPoint Games



- ☀ Highlight the word False
- ☀ Click Insert
- ☀ Click Hyperlink
- ☀ Choose **Place in this Document**
- ☀ Choose the slide "Sorry, try again"
- ☀ Click **OK**



Linking Slides for Games

- ☀ *Repeat* this process to *link* the slide “Correct” with the slide “Question 2”
- ☀ *Link* the slide “Sorry” with Question 1”
- ☀ Once all of the hyperlinks have been set, play the slideshow, answering the question incorrectly the first time, and question correctly the second attempt.



Linking Slides for Games

- ☀ Repeat the same process for each question.
- ☀ Or *select* slides 2, 3, 4 & 5
- ☀ Duplicate them (CTRL+D)
- ☀ *The links will duplicate along with the slides, then just change the content of each slide and re-set the links*
- ☀ Slides are linked by **the titles**, to keep things simple, type a the question number in the section “Click here to add title”

Animation

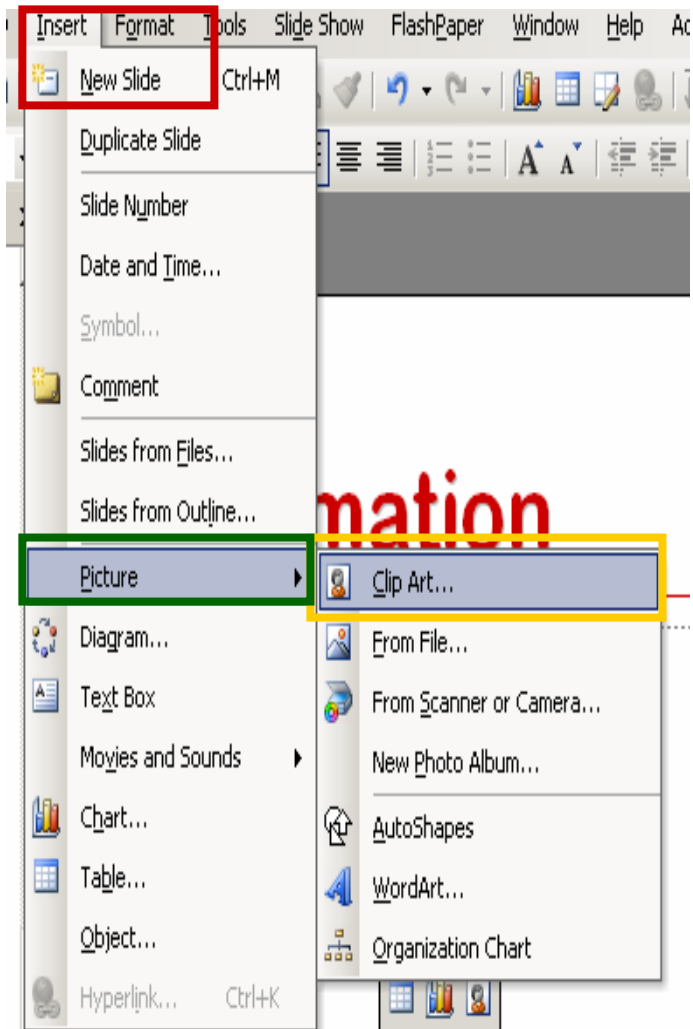


Animation

- ☀ Animation is a great way to work with students to show how things evolve, grow, and/or go through a life cycle.
- ☀ Animation is also a great way to have fun with the software.
- ☀ In this lesson we will create a simple animation project using clipart
- ☀ To get the background, I found a photograph in clip art, resized it to cover the slide



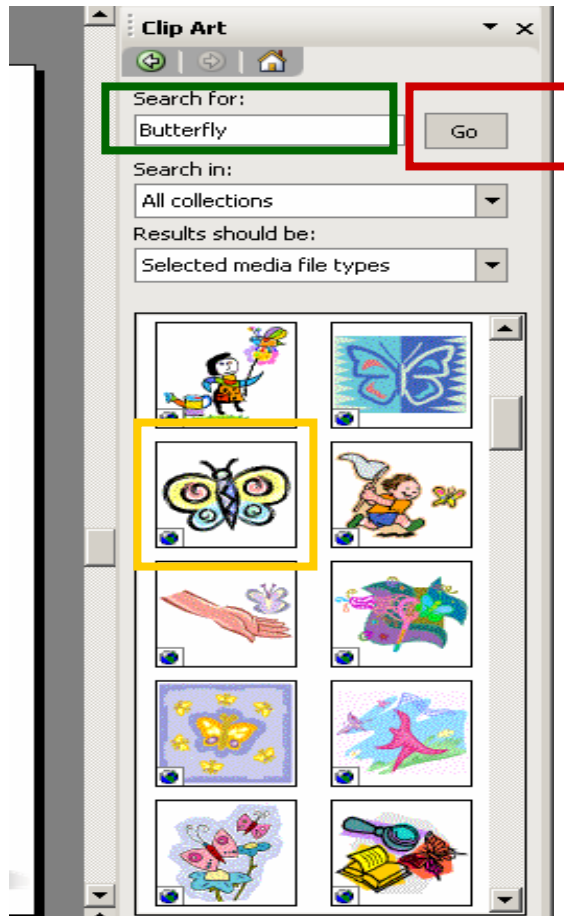
Animation



- ☀ *Open* the Slideshow "PowerPointoons"
- ☀ *Select* Slide 1
- ☀ Click **Insert**
- ☀ Click **Picture**
- ☀ Click **Clipart**



Animation



- ☀ In the search for window, *type* **Butterfly**
- ☀ *Click* **Go**
- ☀ *Double-Click* on one of the **Butterflies** -*make sure that it has a clear background!*



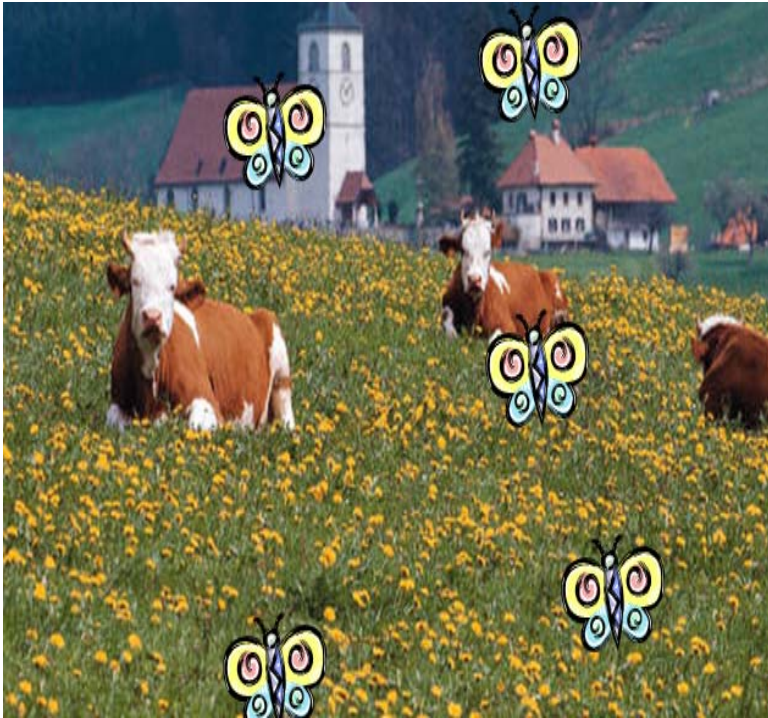
Animation



- ☀ *Resize* the callout by dragging the toggles
- ☀ *Move* the Butterfly to the right edge
- ☀ Duplicate (**CTRL+D**) the slide (The slide must have a **Blue Border** to duplicate it)
- ☀ Duplicate the Butterfly
- ☀ *Move* the Butterflies slightly from right to left



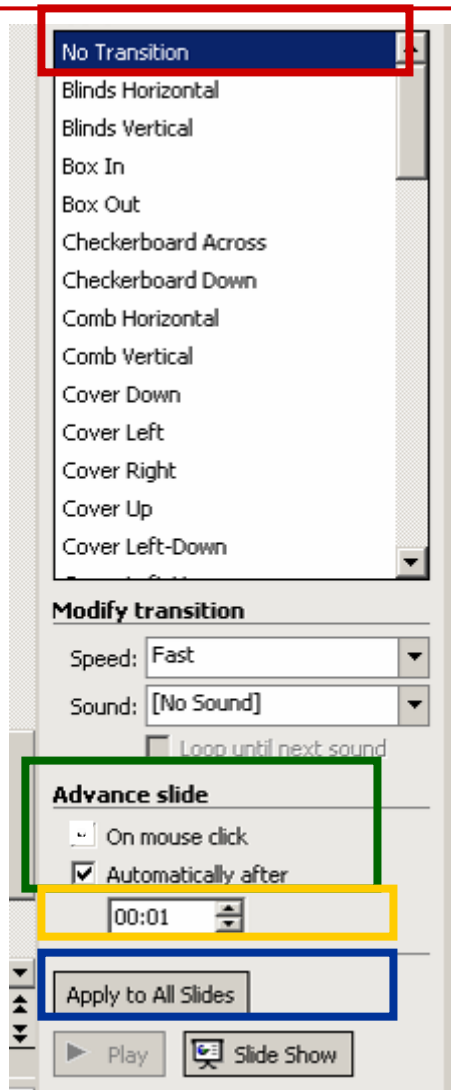
Animation



- ☀ Repeat the process of duplication on several slides, moving the butterflies across the image, until all of the butterflies have moves across the screen



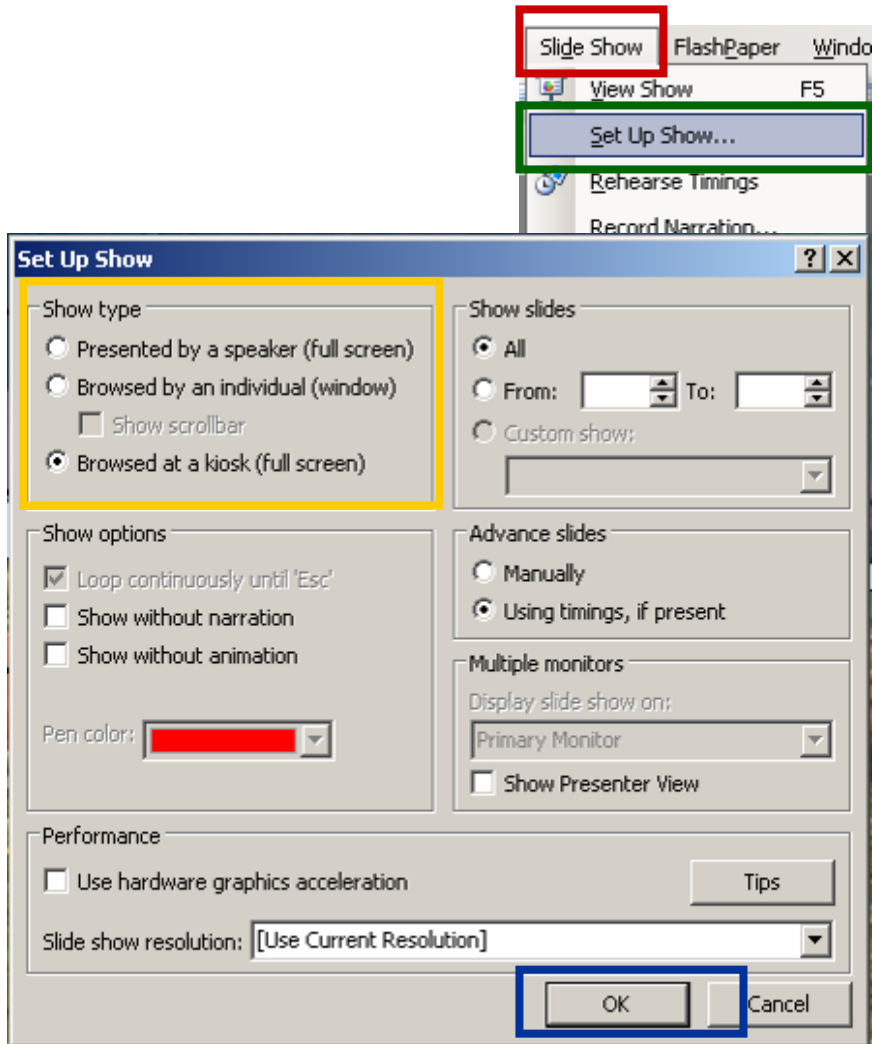
Animation



- ☀ *Click Slide Transition* on the task pane
- ☀ *Choose **No Transition***
- ☀ Under **Advance slide**, *click **Automatically After***
- ☀ *Change the time to **0 seconds***
- ☀ *Click **Apply to All Slides***



Animation



- ☀ *Click Slide Show*
- ☀ *Choose Set up Show*
- ☀ *Under Show Type, click Browsed at Kiosk*
- ☀ *Click OK*
- ☀ *Save*
- ☀ *Click View*
- ☀ *Click Slideshow*

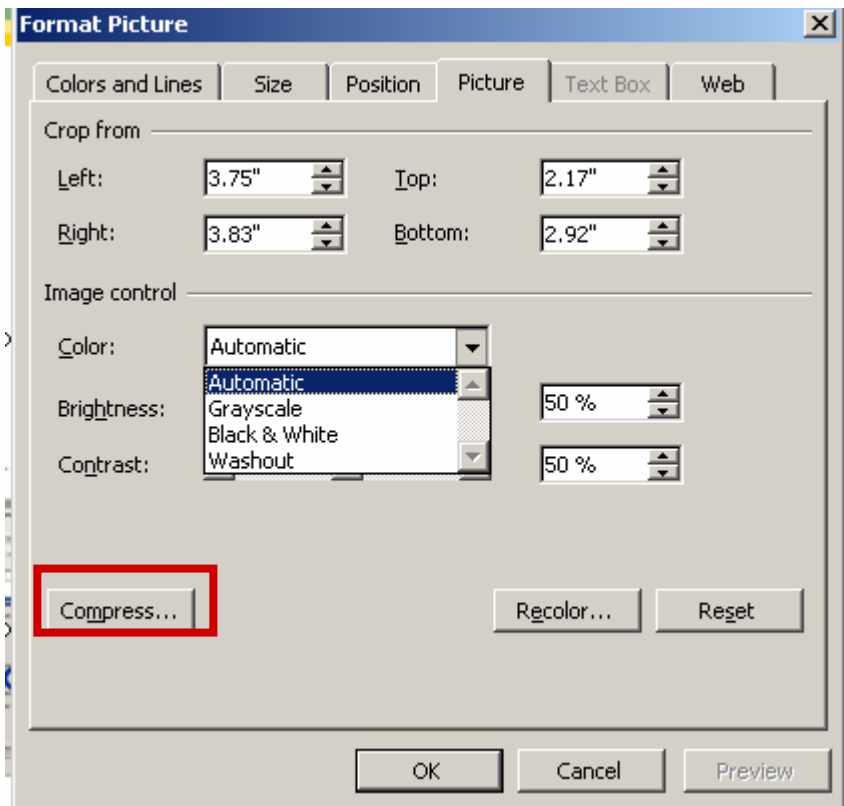




Options for Saving and Playback



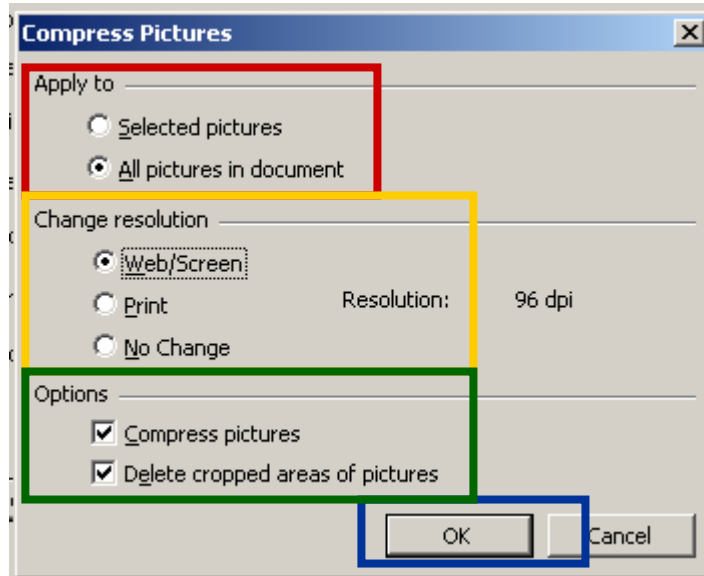
Compress Pictures



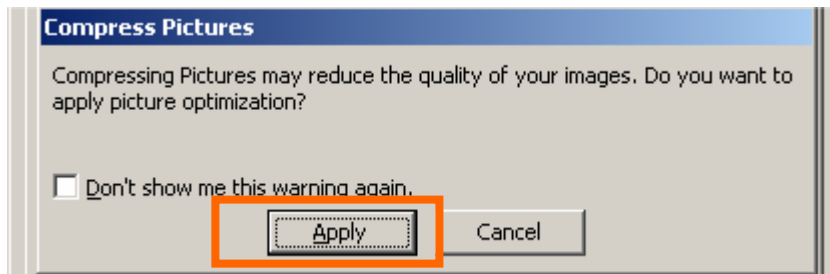
- ☀ The compress option is a great way to reduce the overall size of the PowerPoint file by 30%, depending on the number of images in the presentation
- ☀ *Double-click* on any image in the Presentation
- ☀ *Click **Compress***



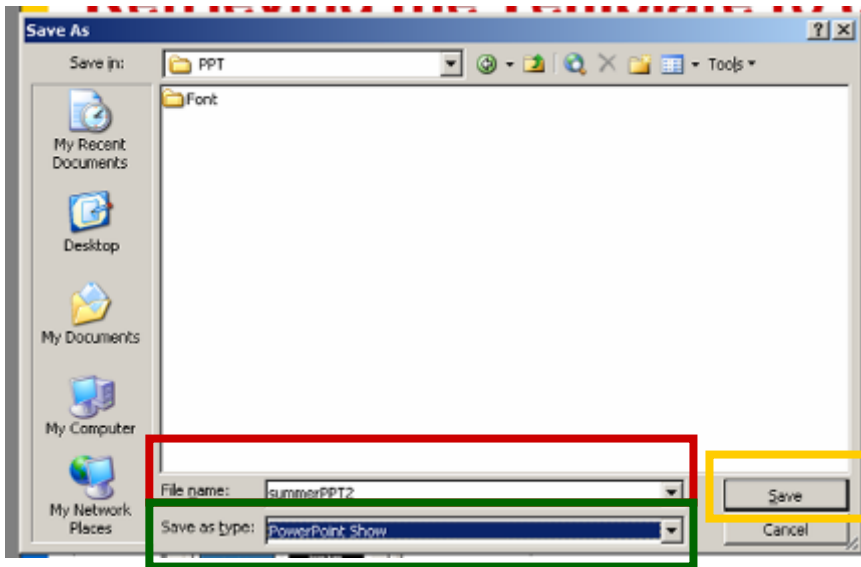
Compress Pictures



- ☀ Under **Apply To**, choose **All pictures in document**
- ☀ Under **Change resolution**, choose **Web/Screen**
- ☀ Under **Options**, choose **BOTH options**
- ☀ Click **OK**
- ☀ On the next screen, choose **Apply**
- ☀ *Click OK*



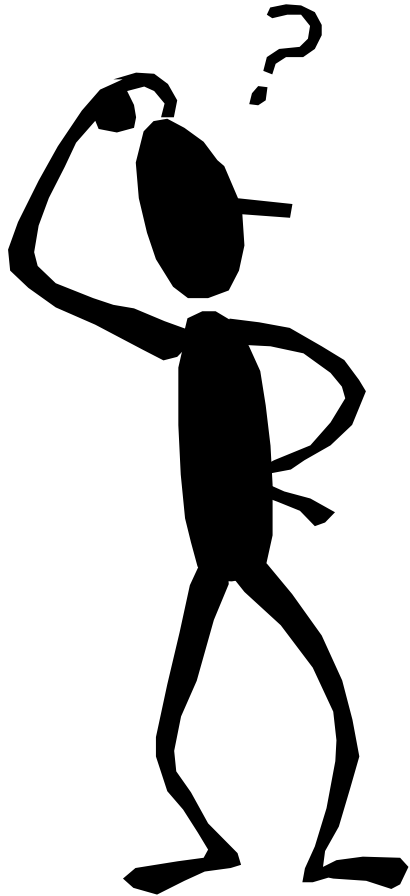
PowerPoint Show



- ☀ Click File
- ☀ Click Save as
- ☀ Choose a **File name**
- ☀ In Save as Type, Choose **PowerPoint Show**
- ☀ Click **Save**
